Project Description	MERC in partnership with Agnico Eagle are looking for two Postdoctoral Fellows and two MSc students to undertake research projects at the Macassa mine area in the Kirkland Lake gold mining camp.
	<b>PDF #1</b> will be responsible for determining the alteration footprint of the gold system within the various lithologic units of the Timiskaming assemblage.
	<b>MSc #1</b> will focus on the analysis and interpretation of hyperspectral data from drill core, which is being acquired on an ongoing basis. The study will characterize the spectral signature of the primary and alteration mineralogy of the gold system and will integrate closely with PDF #1.
	<b>PDF #2</b> will focus on the structural and stratigraphic controls on the mineralization in the Kirkland Lake camp. A strong field mapping background in structural geology is required as well as additional expertise in volcanology and/or clastic sedimentology.
	<b>MSc #2</b> will focus on the stratigraphy and geochronology within the Timiskaming assemblage, integrating closely with PDF #2.
	This is a two year fully funded project involving extensive fieldwork in Kirkland lake with surface and subsurface mapping and relogging of drill sections across the strata hosting the gold deposits. The project will start in May 2024, or sooner.
